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The City of Frankfurt/Main is the host for the European Biennial of Contemporary Art, Manifesta 4. From 25 May to 25 August 2002, artists and artist groups living and working in Europe, the curators, the organizational team and the City of Frankfurt are supporting and stimulating each other in order to create a dialogue, a flux among themselves stressing the different realities of individuals and the way people work together. The Manifesta 4 project has developed through a process of collaboration among three curators: Iara Boubnova, Founding Director of the Institute of Contemporary Art in Sofia, Nuria Enguita Mayo, Chief Curator at Fundació Antoni Tàpies in Barcelona, and Stéphanie Moisdon Trembley, an independent curator and co-founder of bdv (bureau des videos), Paris with the support of many institutions and individuals in Frankfurt and throughout Europe.

The Manifesta 4 project will include permanent displays of works at the exhibition venues, a video-landscape, presentations, broadcasting projects in collaboration with radio and tv, performances, video programs and a continuous discussion forum on the web. Projects in the urban domain will supplement the various exhibition venues in different parts of the city's topography.

The organization and execution of Manifesta 4 is in the hands of the Künstlerhaus Mousonturm, a centre for contemporary art. Within Mousonturm an organizing team has been set up with the director of Mousonturm, Dieter Buroch as General Manager and Martin Fritz as General Co-ordinator. The city's nomination was initiated by the head of the Frankfurter Kunstverein, Nicolaus Schafhausen.

The Manifesta 4 team is assisted by a Frankfurt Advisory Board which has been especially appointed for the project. Under the Chairmanship of Nicolaus Schafhausen (Frankfurter Kunstverein), it is composed of Andreas Bee (Museum für Moderne Kunst), Daniel Birnbaum (Städelschule), Hedwig Fijen (General Secretary of the International Foundation Manifesta), Max Hollein (Kunsthalle Schirn), Sabine Schulze (Städelisches Kunstinstitut) and Kurt Wettengl (Historisches Museum).

Since 1996, the Manifesta Biennial has taken place in changing countries and cities within Europe. The launch in Rotterdam was followed by Luxembourg in 1998 and Ljubljana in 2000. To date, a total of about two hundred artists from 46 European countries have participated in Manifesta.


